- Watch and understand the students' behaviors.

All First Student drivers and attendants receive anti-bullying training and are empowered to:

- Create a safe and respectful environment on the school bus.
- Establish and enforce bus safety rules.
- Recognize the signs of bullying and how to effectively intervene.
- Understand the additional challenges students with disabilities face.
- Empower children to report if they are being bullied or see bullying.
- Report all bullying incidents to management and school district customers immediately.

If you suspect your child is being bullied:

- Ask questions and take time to listen to the answers.
- Speak to school authorities, a teacher, a bus driver or school counselor
- Assess the situation and determine what your child needs in order to feel safe.
